BEGINNING READERS (JP)

Emergent Readers

- Very large type
- Short easy words
- Simple sentences
- Word repetition
- Illustrations on every page

Beginning Readers

- Large type
- Increased vocabulary
- 2-3 sentences per page
- Illustrations on most pages

Early Readers

- Smaller type
- More complex stories with dialogue
- May contain chapters
- Fewer illustrations

NONFICTION BOOKS

Children are more likely to read a book on a topic that interests them! Nonfiction books are grouped by topic with all reading levels represented, including beginning readers, within each subject.

- Short chapters
- Larger font size
- Illustrations throughout that support the text
- A length of 60-130 pages
